Doc Holliday's Immortals 2016 ANNUAL Stages

WARM UP STAGE



START



Ammo: Pistols 10, Rifle 10 Shotgun 4+

Staging: Rifle loaded with 10 rounds, staged on the right table at center of stage
Pistols loaded with 5 rounds each and holstered
Shotgun open and empty staged on the bar

Start: Standing behind the left table.

Procedure: Say "I'm Your Huckleberry" and wait for the beep.

At the beep, with pistols as needed, engage P1 - P4 with a Nevada Sweep, from either direction.

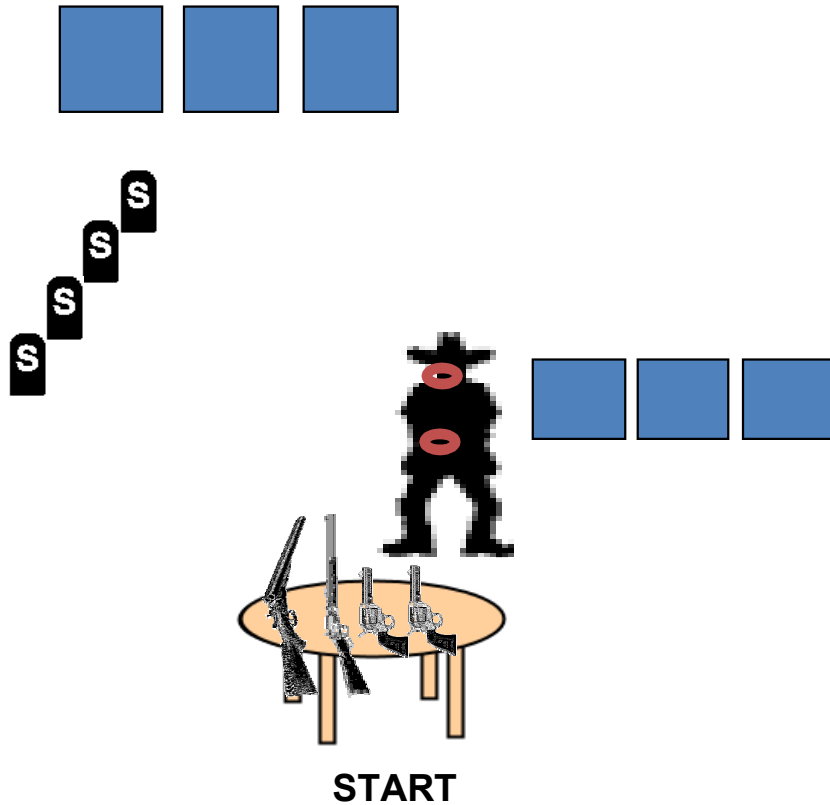
With rifle, engage R1 - R4 with a Nevada Sweep, from either direction.

With shotgun, engage shotgun targets in any order.

Doc Holliday's Immortals 2016 ANNUAL Stages

STAGE 1 ED BAILEY

Doc is playin poker with Ed Bailey...and wipin him out. Ed accuses Doc of cheatin and tells him he's not afraid of him as, without his guns, he's just "a skinny lunger". Ed goes for his pistol, but before he gets close, Doc has two pistols pointed at him. Doc puts his pistols on the table and asks Ed if they can be friends. Ed goes for his gun again and Doc pulls a knife and ends the fight.



Ammo: Pistols 10, Rifle 10, Shotgun 4+

Staging: Rifle loaded with 10 rounds, staged on the table
Pistols loaded with 5 rounds each and **STAGED** on the table
Shotgun open and empty staged on the table

Start: Standing behind the table, hands flat on your pistols.

Procedure: Say “**There, now we can be friends again**” and wait for the beep.

At the beep, with pistols as needed, engage the "Ed" targets until broken then place remaining rounds on P1 - P3 in any order, single taps only.

With rifle, engage R1 through R3 with at least 3 rounds on each in any order.

With shotgun, engage shotgun targets in any order.

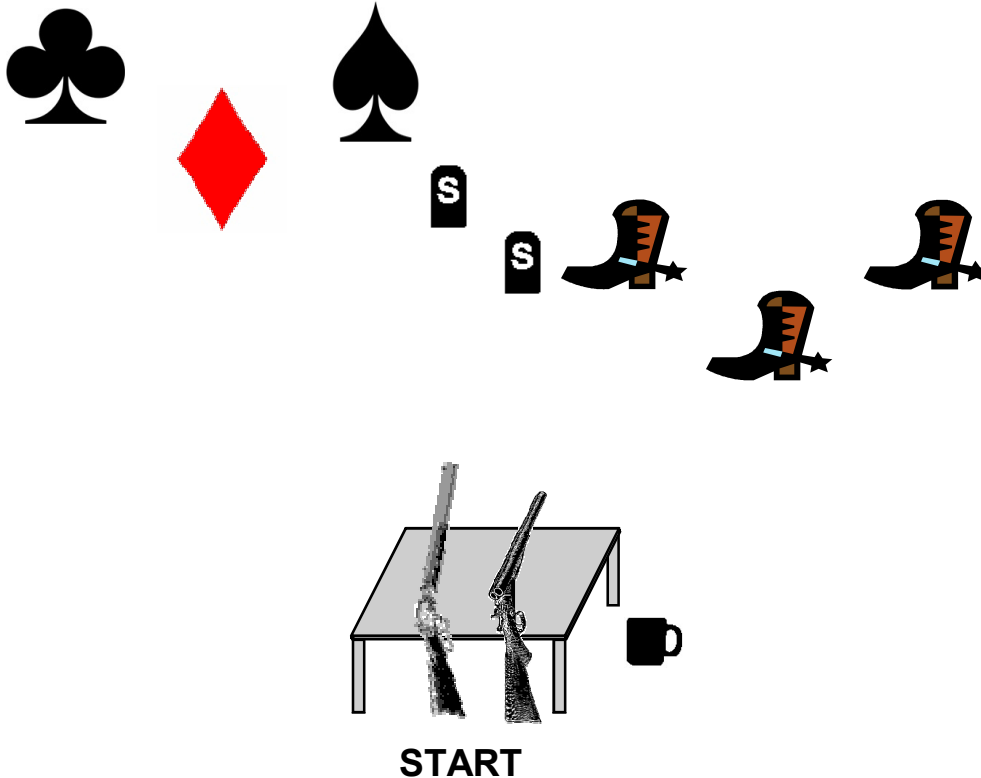
Note: Unbroken Ed targets (clays) will count as misses.

Pistols may be holstered or returned to the table.

STAGE 2 IN MY PRIME

A tense meeting at the Oriental is taking place between Wyatt Earp and Doc Holliday and the Cowboys, led by Curly Bill and fueled by the antics of Ike Clanton and Johnny Ringo. Curly Bill is playing Faro and dealer Wyatt makes no bones that he is retired as a lawman. Johnny Ringo asks Doc if he's retired too. Doc quips "Not me, I'm in my prime".



Ammo: Pistols 10, Rifle 10, Shotgun 2+

Staging: Rifle loaded with 10 rounds, staged on the table. Pistols loaded with five rounds each and holstered, shotgun open and empty, staged on the table.

Start: Standing behind table, holding cup in one hand.

Procedure: Say "Not me, I'm in my prime" and wait for the beep.

At the beep, with pistols as needed, engage P1 - P3 with a continuous Raindrop Loop, from either direction.

With rifle, engage R1 through R3 with a Raindrop Loop, from either direction.

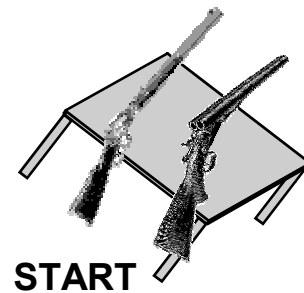
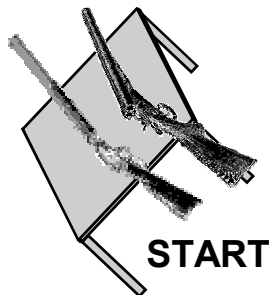
Engage shotgun targets in any order

Note: A Raindrop Loop is shot R1, R3, R2, R1, R3, R2, R1, etc.

STAGE 3 AN EDUCATED MAN

As the banter between Doc and Johnny Ringo continues, they proceed to a conversation in Latin. After a brief exchange between the two, tensions rise and Tombstone marshal Fred White tells both "We don't want any trouble in here, not in any language". Talking to Big Nose Kate, Doc says "evidently Mr. Ringo is an educated man, now I really hate him".



Ammo: Pistols 10, Rifle 10, Shotgun 4+

Staging: Rifle loaded with 10 rounds and staged on either table
Pistols loaded with five rounds each and holstered
Shotgun open and empty, staged on the same table as rifle

Start: Standing behind either table, one hand on rifle.

Procedure: Say "Now I really hate him!" and wait for the beep.

At the beep, with rifle engage R1 - R5 with two Odds n Evens Sweeps, from the same direction each time.

Engage shotgun targets in any order.

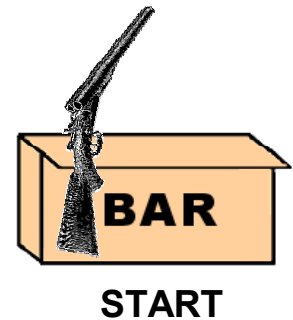
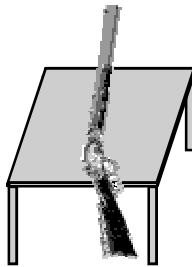
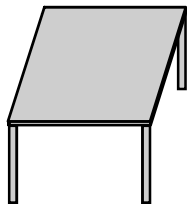
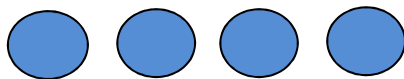
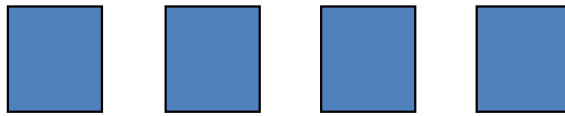
Move to within kicking distance of the stone and with pistols as needed, engage P1 - P5 with two Odds n Evens Sweeps, from the same direction.

Note: A Odds n Evens Sweep is shot: 1-3-5-4-2

STAGE 4 LET'S HAVE A SPELLING CONTEST

Doc has been playing poker for many hours and now Ike Clanton has joined the game. Doc has just won 12 hands in a row and Ike accuses him of cheating. Doc, drunk as he is, pokes fun at Ike and tells him that maybe poker isn't his game. He tells Ike, "I know, let's have a spelling contest". At that Ike jumps to his feet and is promptly ushered away by Wyatt Earp and Ike's friends.



Ammo: Pistols 10, Rifle 10, Shotgun 4+

Staging: Rifle loaded with 10 rounds, staged on the right table in center stage
Pistols loaded with 5 rounds each and holstered
Shotgun open and empty staged on the bar

Start: Standing behind bar, finger pointing up.

Procedure: Say "I know, let's have a spelling contest" and wait for the beep.

At the beep, Engage shotgun targets in any order.

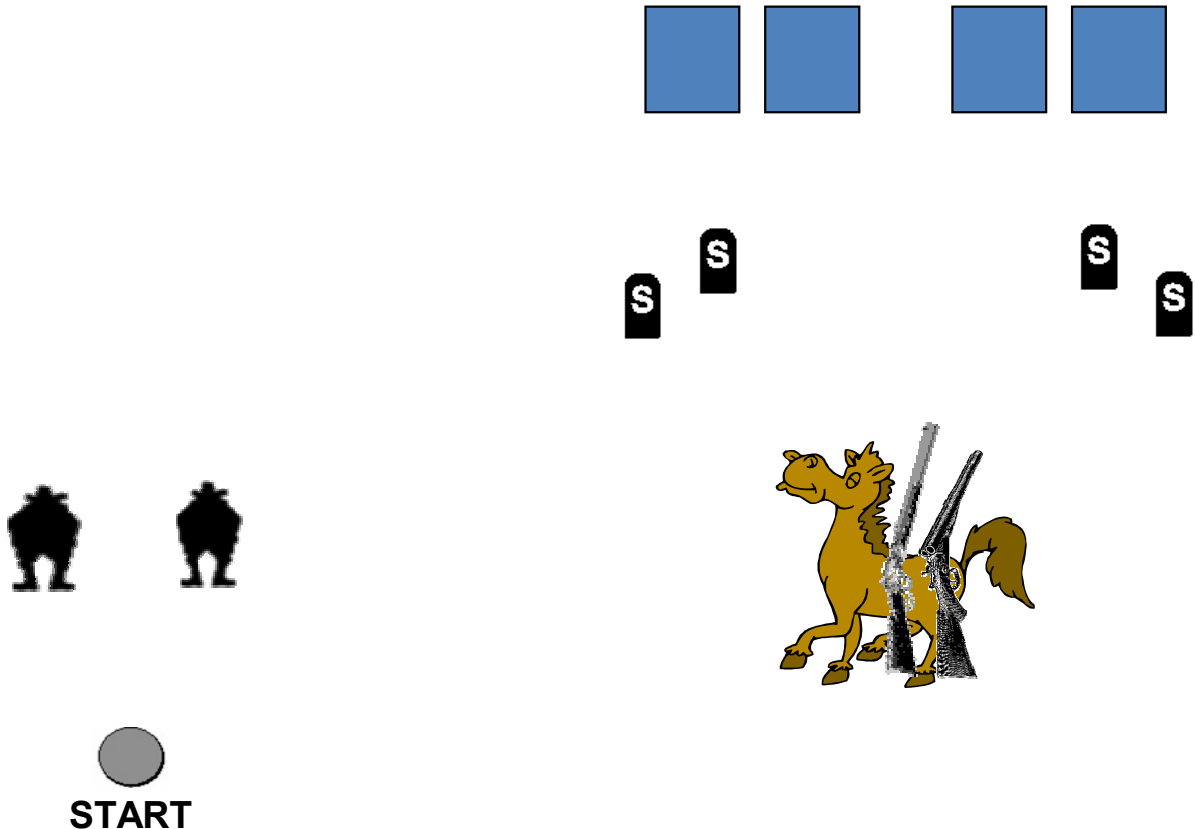
With rifle engage R1 - R4 with a Nevada Sweep, from either direction.

From left table, with pistols as needed, engage P1 - P4 with a continuous Nevada Sweep, from either direction.

STAGE 5 DRUNK PIANO PLAYER

Tombstone Marshall Fred White has just been shot by Curly Bill and Wyatt Earp is taking Curly in, but the Cowboys will have none of it. Wyatt has a gun on Ike Clanton when Billy Clanton moves in to intervene. Doc Holliday calls out "and you, music lover, you're next". Billy turns and tells Doc that he's too drunk to hit anything and that he's probably seeing double. Doc tells him that he has two guns, "one for each of ya".



Ammo: Pistols 10, Rifle 10, Shotgun 4+

Staging: Rifle loaded with 10 rounds, staged on the horse
Pistols loaded with 5 rounds each and holstered
Shotgun open and empty, staged on the horse

Start: Standing with one foot touching the Start stone, hands on pistols.

Procedure: Say "I have two guns, one for each of ya" and wait for the beep.

At the beep, with pistols as needed, engage P1 and P2 with a Lawrence Welk Sweep, from either direction .

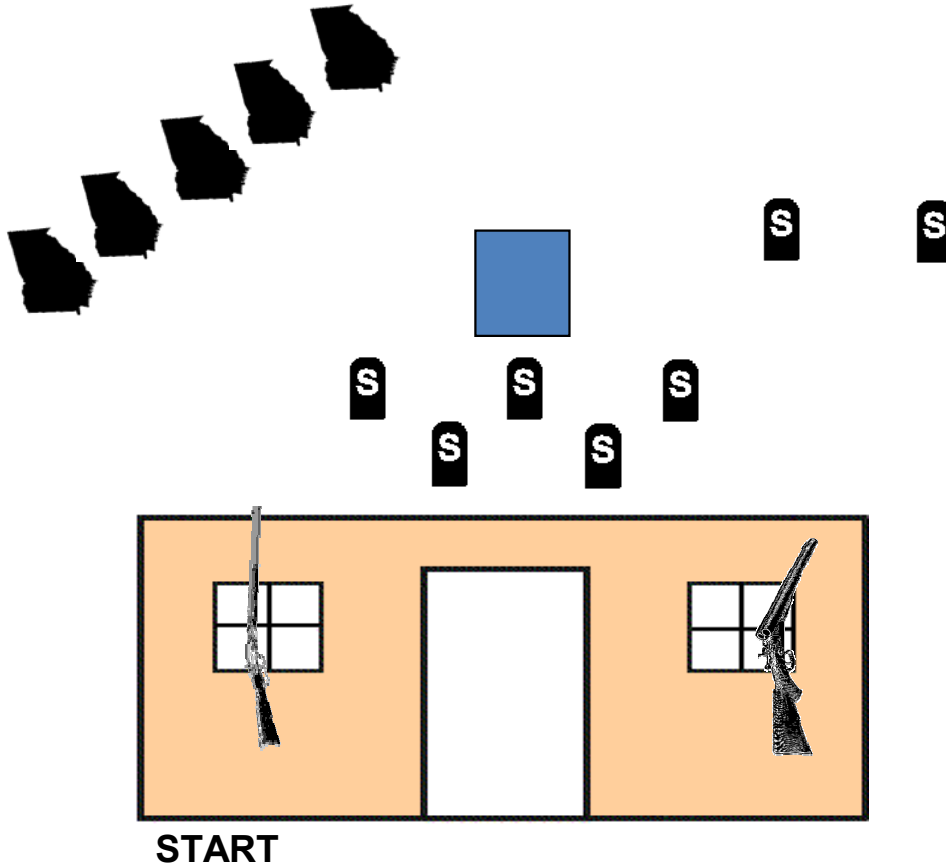
Move to horse and with rifle, engage R1 - R4 with a Lawrence Welk Sweep, from either direction.
Engage shotgun targets in any order.

Note: A Lawrence Welk Nevada Sweep is shot, 1 round on 1, 2 on 2, 3 on 1 and 4 on target 2.

STAGE 6 DAISY IF YA DO

The Gunfight at the OK Corral has begun and shots are flyin everywhere. Frank McLaury, although he's been shot, thinks Doc is out of ammunition and tells him "I got you now you..." Doc tells him "you're a daisy if ya do". McLaury tries, but Doc is much faster and, with the last round in his pistol, Doc takes care of poor Frank for good.



Ammo: Pistols 10, Rifle 10, Shotgun 2+

Staging: Rifle loaded with 10 rounds, staged in the left window tray
Pistols loaded with 5 rounds each and holstered
Shotgun open and empty staged in the right window tray

Start: Standing at left window, hands on window frame.

Procedure: Say "You're a daisy if ya do." and wait for the beep.

At the beep, with rifle engage R1 - R5 with two on each, in any order.

Move to doorway and with pistols as needed, engage the pistol knockdown targets, in any order.

Any remaining pistol rounds will be fired at the dump target.

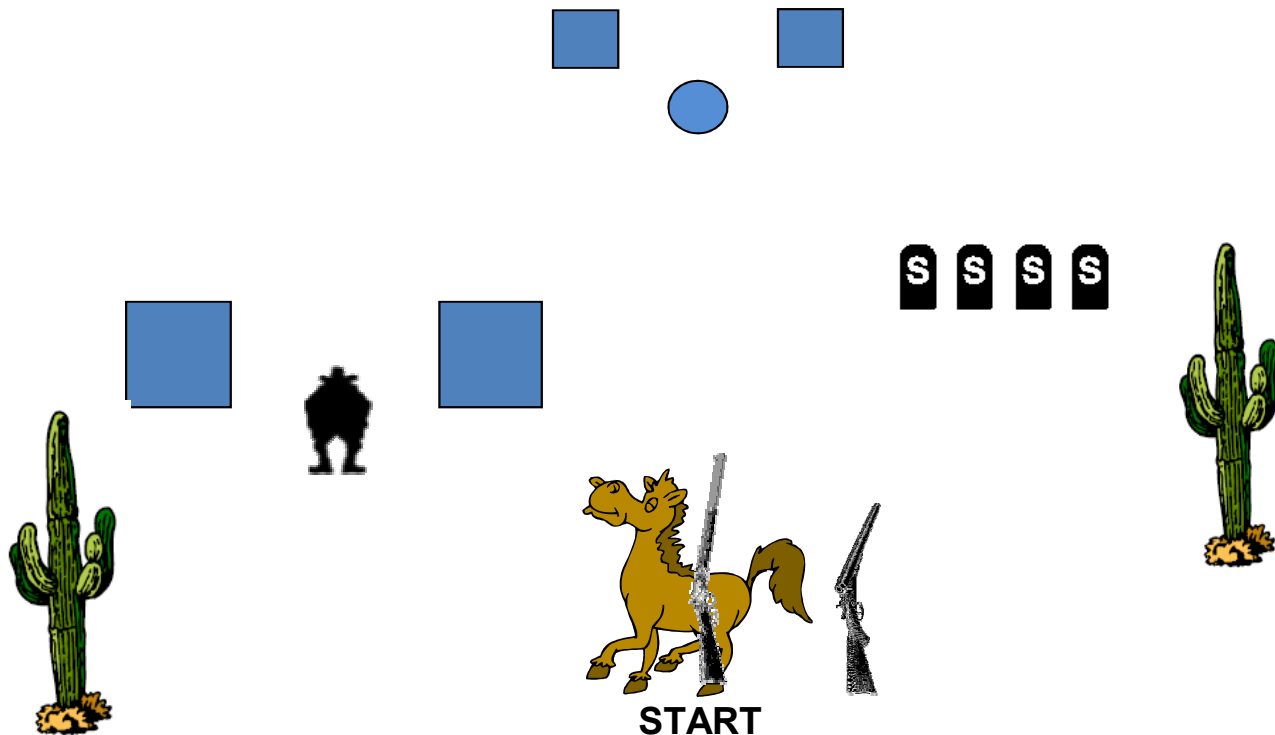
From right window, engage the shotgun targets in any order.

Note: Misses on the pistol knockdowns will not count as misses unless they are left standing.
Misses on the dump target will count as misses.

STAGE 7 JOHNNY RINGO'S DEMISE

Johnny Ringo has had it in for Wyatt Earp ever since he arrived in Tombstone. He finally calls him out in a man on man shootout. Wyatt knows he's not fast enough to beat Ringo, but he also knows this will not go away. They are to meet at the mouth of Sulphur Springs Canyon, but Doc, not Wyatt, arrives to meet Ringo. To Ringo's surprise, Doc steps out of the shadows and says "Johnny Ringo, you look like somebody just walked over your grave."



Ammo: Pistols 10, Rifle 10, Shotgun 4+

Staging: Rifle loaded with 10 rounds, staged on the horse
Pistols loaded with 5 rounds each and holstered
Shotgun open and empty, held in both hands

Start: Standing behind horse, shotgun held in both hands.

Procedure: Say "You look like somebody just walked over your grave" and wait for the beep.

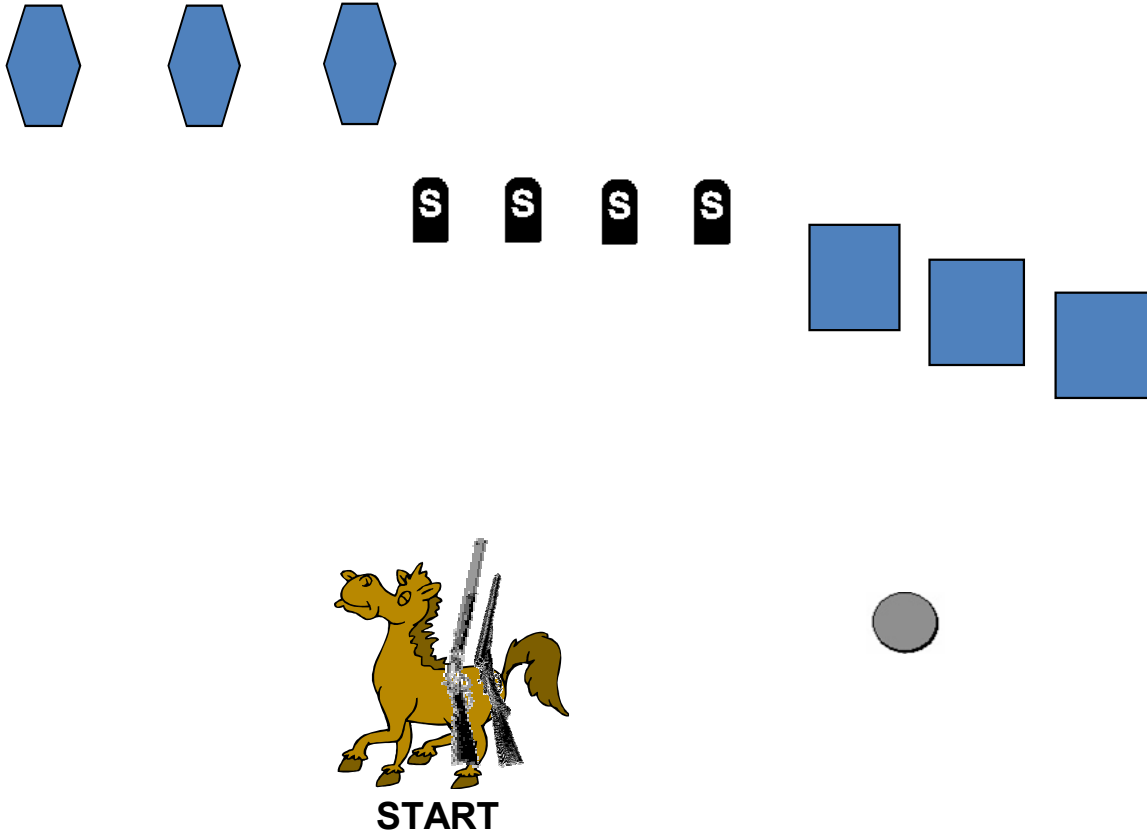
At the beep, engage shotgun targets in any order.

With rifle, engage R1 - R3 a Nevada Sweep, starting on the center target.

With pistols as needed, engage P1 - P3 with a continuous Nevada Sweep, starting on the center target.

Doc Holliday's Immortals 2016 ANNUAL Stages
STAGE 8 BY ALL MEANS

Doc Holliday and the rest of Wyatt Earp's Immortals are out to break the Cowboys once and for all. They'll arrest them if they can, or if there's resistance, all the better. Doc and Turkey Creek Johnson burst into an opium den and find two Cowboys. Johnson yells "nobody move!" Doc tells them "nonsense, by all means, move".



Ammo: Pistols 10, Rifle 10, Shotgun 4+

Staging: Rifle loaded with 10 rounds, staged on the horse
Pistols loaded with 5 rounds each and holstered
Shotgun open and empty staged on the horse

Start: Standing behind the horse, rifle held in both hands.

Procedure: Say "By all means, move!" and wait for the beep.

At the beep, with rifle engage R1 - R3 with double taps in the sequence, R1, R2, R1, R3, R1.

Engage shotgun targets in any order.

Move to within kicking distance of the stone and with pistols as necessary, engage P1 - P3 with same sequence as rifle. (pistol sweep is continuous)

Note: Sweeps are shot from either direction.
