



DHI FEBRUARY '16 MATCH

WARM UP STAGE



Ammo: Pistols 10, Rifle 10 Shotgun 4+

Staging: Rifle loaded with 10 rounds, staged on the right table; pistols loaded with 5 rounds each and holstered; shotgun open and empty staged on the bar.

Start: Standing behind the left table.

Procedure: Say "Let's Shoot!" and wait for the beep.

At the beep, With pistols as needed, engage P1 and P2 with double taps alternating, from either direction.




With rifle, engage R1 and R2 with Double Taps alternating, from either direction.

With shotgun, engage shotgun targets in any order.

DHI FEBRUARY '16 STAGES

STAGE 1 RABBITS

Rowdy Ranger Rick is a patient man, but he's about at his limit with the rabbits. Ya see, these loveable, furry critters have about overrun the DHI spread and he's had it! He's tried the humane way but now he's taken up arms to get rid of them once and for all.



START

Ammo: Pistols 10, Rifle 10, Shotgun 4+

Staging: Rifle loaded with 10 rounds, held in both hands; pistols loaded with 5 rounds each and holstered; shotgun open and empty staged on the horse.

Start: Standing with one foot touching the Start stone, rifle held in both hands.


Procedure: Say “**Go on, GET!**” and wait for the beep. ATB, with rifle, engage R1 - R4 with a Reverse Lawrence Welk Sweep from either direction. Make rifle safe on horse and engage shotgun targets in any order. With pistols as needed, engage P1 - P4 with a continuous Reverse Lawrence Welk Sweep, from either direction.

Reverse Lawrence Welk: 4 shots on 1st target, 3 on 2nd, 2 on 3rd and 1 on last target.

DHI FEBRUARY '16 STAGES

STAGE 2 THE HENHOUSE

A wily fox has been getting in the henhouse and Shootin Sharyn is fed up! She's tired of losin eggs and some of her best friers to a four-footed thief. She's got the rifle loaded up and been lyin in wait for the varmint.



Ammo: Pistols 10, Rifle 10, Shotgun 4+

Staging: Rifle loaded with 10 rounds, staged on the cow; shotgun on cow, pistols loaded with 5 rounds each and holstered.

Start: Standing within kicking distance of the Start stone, hands hanging at sides.

Procedure: Say “I got ya now!” and wait for the beep. ATB with pistols as needed, engage P1 P1 - P3 with a continuous Double-Tap Nevada Sweep, from either direction.


Move to cow and engage R1 - R3 with a Double-Tap Nevada Sweep, from either direction.

Engage shotgun pop-ups in any order. Misses on pop-ups don't count as misses. If both pop ups are hit it's a 5 second bonus.

DHI FEBRUARY '16 STAGES

STAGE 3 DAUGHTERS

Steamboat is not a man to be trifled with when it comes to his daughters. He's even taught em to shoot for themselves and you'd better watch yourself if you even think about getting outta line cuz that Rapidfire Rachel can shoot!



Ammo: Pistols 10, Rifle 10, Shotgun 2+

Staging: Rifle loaded with 10 rounds, held in both hands at waist level; pistols loaded with 5 rounds each and holstered; shotgun open and empty staged on either horse.

Start: Standing with at least one foot touching the start stone, with rifle in both hands at waist level.

Procedure: Say “**You what?**” and wait for the beep.

ATB, with rifle engage R1 - R5 with two Sweeps, from the same direction.

Move to a front horse and make rifle safe. With shotgun,

With shotgun engage TWO shotgun targets in any order.

With pistols as needed, engage P1 - P5 with two Sweeps, from the same direction.


Note: You may move **before** to shooting the pistols, but **not shooting on the move**.

DHI FEBRUARY '16 STAGES

STAGE 4 FATHERS AND SONS

Loose Trigger has spent a lotta years honing his shootin skills, and it shows. Why he's smooth as silk and deadly accurate. Now if he could only get that Bushshot Bill to pay attention and learn a thing or two.

Ya see, Bushshot is always in a hurry. Rush to do this, push to do that. Faster, faster all the time. If Loose Trigger could just get him to slow down a bit, he'd be smooth as dad.



START

Ammo: Pistols 10, Rifle 10, Shotgun 4+

Staging: Rifle loaded with 10 rounds, staged on the right table; pistols loaded with 5 rounds each and **staged** on the left table; shotgun open and empty staged on the bar.

Start: Standing in center doorway.

Procedure: Say “**I don't know 'bout him**” and wait for the beep.

ATB, shooter's choice to move to left table or bar. With pistols as needed, engage P1 and P2 with two 3-2 Sweeps, from either direction each time.

With rifle, engage R1 and R2 with two 3-2 Sweeps, from either direction each time.

Engage shotgun targets in any order.


(If starting on right, reverse the order guns)

Note: Pistols may be holstered or returned to the table.

DHI FEBRUARY '16 STAGES

STAGE 5 KODA'S WOOLIES

The woolliest chaps ever seen here by the DHI Cowboys are worn by a fella named Koda Joe. Now Koda has some fine artillery as well, but them chaps are his signature and he can be seen wearin em no matter how hot it gets, he just don't care. He's the envy of all the cowboys with his woolies.



Ammo: Pistols 10, Rifle 10, Shotgun 4+

Staging: Rifle loaded with 10 rounds, staged on the left horse; pistols loaded with 5 rounds each and holstered, shotgun open and empty staged on either horse.

Start: Standing behind either horse, hands touching hat.

Procedure: Say "I don't give a hoot!" and wait for the beep.

ATB, with rifle engage R1 - R3 with a Raindrop Loop. Engage left shotgun targets in any order, then take shotgun to right horse and make safe.

With pistols as needed, engage P1 - P3 with a continuous Raindrop Loop.

Engage remaining shotgun targets in any order.

Note: A Raindrop Loop is shot in a continuous circle, R1, R2, R3, R1, R2, R3 etc.


Set-up crew: R2 and P2 are higher than R/P 1 and 3.

DHI FEBRUARY '16 STAGES

STAGE 6 BROKEN HEARTED

It's Valentine's Day and everyone at Marshal Ruger's house forgot. Oh, they didn't forget Valentine's Day, they forgot HIM. Ya see, they were so busy getting Valentines for everyone else, they didn't get him one.

Now the Marshal's not an emotional guy, he's just a little miffed over all of it.



START

Ammo: Pistols 10, Rifle 10, Shotgun 4+

Staging: Rifle loaded with 10 rounds, staged on the left horse, pistols loaded with 5 rounds each and holstered; shotgun open and empty staged on the right horse.

Start: Standing at left horse, hands touching rifle.

Procedure: Say “**Who needs a Valentine anyway?**” and wait for the beep. ATB, Engage R1 - ATB, Engage R1 - R4 with a Cat Herder's Sweep, from either direction.

With pistols as needed, engage P1 - P4 with a continuous Cat Herder's Sweep, from either direction.

From right horse, engage shotgun targets in any order.

Note: A Cat Herder's Sweep is shot the same as a Nevada Sweep only double-tapping the end targets.
